Women's Service

Supported, short-term accommodation for women experiencing, or at risk of, homelessness.

What is our Women's Service?

Located in East Perth, this service provides short-term accommodation while you are actively seeking to secure long-term accommodation.

Our female only accommodation offers single rooms with access to private or shared bathrooms, common cooking areas and a laundry.

You will have regular access to a support team who will work with you to develop an individual recovery plan and help you explore suitable accommodation options.

We also offer a range of support, referrals and other services that help you improve your personal health and wellbeing, with a view to reconnect you with friends and family where possible.

Women's Support Services

We base our services on a recovery and trauma-informed practice. As your level of independence and confidence grows you become ready to move into long-term accommodation.



SUPPORT

Access to regular meetings with a support team and wellbeing chaplaincy service.



ASSISTANCE

Exploring long-term accommodation options and growing independent living skills.



ADVOCACY

We provide advice and advocacy as well as access to external agencies.



ACTIVITIES

Groups, meetings and other activities that encourage you to socialise and engage in the community.



REFERRAL

Referral to appropriate health and community support agencies.

Who is Eligible ?

Women over 18 years (Priority to those over 50 years)

- Experiencing, or at risk of homelessness.
- Currently residing in Western Australia.
- A Permanent Resident or Citizen of Australia.
- Currently receiving or entitled to an income such as Centrelink or a regular wage.
- Personal needs that are able to be managed by the service.
- Willing to proactively engage in an individual recovery plan.
- Be able to live independently and willing to live in a shared environment.
- Women who are willing to agree to the terms of our Licence to Occupy, Charter of Rights and Responsibilities and Accommodation rules, and who wish to find long-term accommodation.

* Please note, in some circumstances, we may not be able to support your needs at our service and will refer you to a more appropriate service.
