

Specialist residential aged care service in East Perth

St Bart's James Watson Centre offers specialist homeless residential aged care to older men who are experiencing or who are at risk of homelessness, and who may be socially or financially disadvantaged.

James Watson Centre is a 40 bedded single room unit which is accredited as an aged care provider by the Aged Care Quality and Safety Commission.

Our central position in a prime inner city location, is in close proximity to essential medical services (including Royal Perth Hospital), as well as shops, public transport, libraries and community centres.

Services

Every room is provided with airconditioning, ensuite bathroom, adjustable bed, TV and an emergency call system to ensure safety.



CARE & SUPPORT

Access to 24/7 nursing and carer support. Staff are experienced in managing challenging behaviours and providing trauma informed support



ACTIVITIES PROGRAM

Designed to provide opportunities for leisure, learning and socialiation.



PASTORAL CARE

A chaplain and a Christian chapel service is offered. Support is provided to facilitate other religious and cultural requirements



MEALS

Nutritious home cooked meals which are reviewed by dietician and residents



ALLIED HEALTH

Access to allied health services such as General Practitioner, Physio, Speech pathologists, dietitians and Occupational therapist

Who is Eligible?

Males who are over 65 years of age, or who are prematurely aged, and are currently experiencing or at risk of homelessness.

To refer a person to James Watson for specialist homeless aged care accommodation, they must have a current ACAT assessment and an Aged Care or Disability Support Pension.
